County, California. BY THE COMMISSION: Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Salal, on its Salt Lake Division in Lassen County. Applicant alleges that no freight or passenger business was transacted at the non-agency of Salal during the annual period ending April 30th, 1928; that the spur track at this point originally was constructed to serve the Lassen

Lumber and Box Company and that this track was removed June 16th, 1928. It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Salal, located on the Susanville Branch of its Salt Lake Division in Lassen County, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records, and cancel all rates, rules and regulations in accordance with the Commission's rules.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
