BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, in its Decision No. 18,955, ordered that Delta Telephone and Telegraph Company might make rearrangements and changes in its telephone service and might file and make effective certain rates, all as set forth therein, after a showing that it had completed construction and rearrangements necessary for the rendering of common battery exchange telephone service within the primary rate areas of the Courtland, Isleton and Walnut Grove Exchanges, and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission has evidence to the effect that Delta Telephone and Telegraph Company has complied with the conditions of the order in Decision No. 18,955, dated October 25, 1927,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Delta Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to make effective,

as of October 1, 1928, rates, primary rate areas and exchange areas, in accordance with the schedules and maps shown in Exhibits "A", "B" and "C" of this Commission's Decision No. 18,955, provided such schedules of rates and maps be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before September 26, 1928, and further provided that mechanical rearrangements of telephone equipment and plant as may be required, affecting service but not rates, may be made on and after the date of this order, in a manner which will cause the least interruption to telephone traffic.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
