FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, through an inadvertance the description of the
 certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to A. Harwood
 by Decision No. 20188 is not in accord with the Commission's declaration
 defining the operating right authorized to be issued,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's order on Page 8 of
 said Decision No. 20188 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience
 and necessity be and the same is hereby granted to A. Harwood for the
 operation of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight
 between Willits and Garberville and the intermediate points of Outlet,
 Arnold, Longvale, Laytonville, Twin Rocks, Cummings, Leggett Valley,
 Rockport, Redwood Flat, Andersonia, Richardson Grove and Piercy, also
 between Laytonville and Branscomb; and for automobile stage service
 as a common carrier of passengers and express between Laytonville
 and Branscomb, subject to the following conditions:

In all other respects the order of the Commission is to remain unchanged.
