SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, filed a second supplemental application in the above entitled proceeding with this Commission on the 31st day of August, 1928, asking for approval of a uniform sign to be installed at all private crossings in conformity with Section IV of our General Order No. 75, and in lieu of the types of private crossing signs heretofore approved by Decision No. 19263 in this proceeding.

It appears that the proposed sign for use at grade crossings should be approved, without prejudice, however, to a later determination by this Commission of a standard sign for such purpose; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to place sign at private grade crossings in conformity with Section IV of General Order No. 75, as shown on Drawing C. E. H. 11316 attached to said second supplemental application, in

lieu of the sign approved by our Decision No. 19263, dated January 20, 1928, in this proceeding, without prejudice, however, to a further determination by this Commission of a standard sign for such purpose.

In all other respects this Commission's orders heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
