BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OFDER.

At the time of the hearing of the above entitled matters, it was contemplated by all parties that the bus service should not be installed until the completion of the tube under the Oakland Estuary. The time of the completion at that time was estimated as October 1, 1928. Since the hearing it has developed that the tube will not be completed as soon as was expected and the City of Alameda and the Key System Transit Company have requested permission to institute the bus service over Webster Street Bridge from October 1, 1928, until such time as the tube is completed. Upon the completion of the tube, the operation will be as outlined in Decision No. 20231. There appearing to be no reasonable objection to the request of the City of Alameda and the Key System Transit Company, the Commission will make the following order:

<u>ORDER-</u>

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pending the opening of the tube under the Oakland Estuary to traffic, the Key System Transit Company shall on October 1, 1928, commence the operation of busses between Oakland and Alameda upon the route as set forth in Decision No. 20231, with whatever variation is necessary to take the busses over the Alameda Bridge on Webster Street instead of through the tube under the Estuary.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that immediately upon the completion of the tube and the opening of the same, that the routing specified in Decision No. 2023L shall be followed.

This is a supplemental order, only for the purpose above mentioned, and is not intended in any way to change or modify Decision No. 20231, except as herein specified.
