The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, filed the above-entitled application with the Commission on the 26th day of July, 1928, asking for authority to abandon its non-agency station at Altura (M.P.651.2) on its Arizona Division in San Bernardino County.

Applicant alleges that no freight or passenger business has been transacted at said station for more than twelve months last past, and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station at Altura (M. P. 651.2) located on the main line of its Arizona Division in San Bernardino County to eliminate said non-agency name from its rates and records and amend its tariffs in conformity with the Commission's rules end regulations.
