O R D E R

G.A. Richardson having applied to this Commission for authority to transfer to A.E. Kirchgater that certain public utility water system known as the "Gould Tract Water System", supplying water for domestic and other purposes to consumers in "Gould or Brooke Realty Co.'s Subdivision No. 112", lying south of the City of Sacramento in Sacramento County, and said A.E. Kirchgater having joined in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that G.A. Richardson be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to A.E. Kirchgater that certain public utility water system known as the "Gould Tract Water System", supplying water for domestic and other purposes to consumers in "Gould or Brooke Realty Co.'s Subdivision No. 112", Sacramento County, and as more particularly described in the application herein, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before the thirty-first day of December, 1928, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by G.A. Richardson within thirty (30) days of the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days of the date on which G.A. Richardson actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
