ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, and Tidewater Southern Railway Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on October 6, 1928, asking for authority to execute an agreement entered into on the 29th day of August, 1928, relating to the joint use of trackage at Modesto, Stanislaus County, as shown by the map attached to the agreement, a copy of which is filed with the joint application, made a part thereof and marked "Exhibit A", and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that the proposed agreement is just and reasonable and that the application should be granted, therefore,
