FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, H. H. Hardwick, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 9495, dated September 12, 1921, and issued on Application No. 6963, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive service for the transportation of passengers and express between Fresno and Orange Cove and intermediate points, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of October 16, 1928, that he is no longer operating said service, declaring that said discontinuance was forced by financial difficulties, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to H. H. Hardwick by Decision No. 9495 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission in the name of H. H. Hardwick, and covering said service, be and the same are hereby canceled.
