In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing it to move and relocate its shelter shed at non-agency station of Hall, Alameda County, California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the 22nd day of October, 1928, asking for authority to move and relocate its shelter shed at the non-agency station of Hall, Alameda County, California, from its present location on the easterly side of the main track to a point directly opposite on the westerly side of said main track.

It appears to this Commission that the present proceeding is not one in which a public hearing is necessary and that this application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and the same is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to move and relocate its shelter shed at the non-agency station of Hall, on its Western Division, in the County of Alameda, State of California, to a location as shown in red on the map (Western Division Drawing No. H-85, Sheet No. 1) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
