ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the cancellation of all rates in freight tariffs to and from its non-agency station of Ivrea on its Shasta Division in Tehama County, California, and to discontinue the handling of freight thereat.

Applicant alleges that no freight business was transacted at said non-agency station during the annual period ending February 29th, 1928. The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified, by letter, that it has no objection to the granting of this application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rates in freight tariffs to and from its non-agency station of Ivrea, located on the main line in its Shasta Division in Tehama County, and to

discontinue the handling of freight thereat, provided, however, that no facilities will be removed from said non-agency station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
