ORDER

Key System Transit Company, a corporation, filed the above entitled application with this Commission on the 16th day of October, 1928, asking for authority to operate one-man street cars on the following lines: 90th Avenue, 23rd Avenue, Fruitvale Avenue, and Cemetery Line, all in the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California.
