 No.10881, granted a certificate of public convenience and neces-
 sity to operate an auto trucking service for the transportation
 of certain commodities between Los Angeles and Imperial Valley
 points has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of
 October 7, 1928, that he has discontinued operation of said ser-
 vice, and

WHEREAS, the Commission has been further advised that said
 Jerome F. Lyon was adjudged a bankrupt on April 22, 1927, now
 Therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience
 and necessity heretofore granted to Jerome F. Lyon by said
 Decision No.14939 be, and the same is hereby revoked and annulled,
 and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time
 schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by said Jerome F.Lyon
 be, and the same are hereby canceled.
