SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, M. F. Smith, to whom the Railroad Commission in
Decision No. 13538 and Decision No. 13499, granted a certificate of
public convenience and necessity to operate an auto trucking service
for the transportation of lumber only between Etna Mills and Mills in
the vicinity of Etna Mills and Montague, via Fort Jones, and serving
Fort Jones as an intermediate, has advised the Commission in a sworn
statement dated November 3, 1928, that he has discontinued operation
of said service, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience
and necessity heretofore granted by said decisions be and the same is
hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules
filed with the Railroad Commission by said M. F. Smith covering said
service be and the same are hereby canceled.
