In the matter of the application of the American Railway Express Company for authority to abandon its agency at Storrie, County of Butte, State of California.

Application No. 15096.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

American Railway Express Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency station of Storrie on the Western Division of the Main Line of The Western Pacific Railroad Company in Plumas County, erroneously stated in the application as Butte County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that the abandonment of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; that the continued maintenance of the agency is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public; that said agency is maintained jointly by The Western Pacific Railroad Company and applicant; and that The Western Pacific Railroad Company has filed Application No. 15117 with this Commission, asking authority to abandon said agency and it becomes necessary for the applicant in this proceeding to seek like authority.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified, by letter, that it will not oppose the granting of this application.

The important shippers and receivers of express at this location have been consulted by a representative of the Engineering Department of the Railroad Commission and no opposition to the granting

of this application was found.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to the American Railway Express Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency station of Storrie, located on the Main Line of the Western Division of The Western Pacific Railroad Company in Plumas County, and to eliminate said agency name from its station records; provided, however, the coincident with the abandonment of said agency station, applicant will accept and deliver express shipments at car door of trains stopping at that point.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
