The Western Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its agency at the station of Storrie on its Western Division in Elumas County.

Applicant alleges that the principal shipper at this station was the R. C. Storrie and Company, a firm of contractors engaged upon the construction of a power plant for the Feather River Power Company and since the completion of this project this agency has become unremunerative and there no longer exists any public necessity for the further continuance of an agency at said station.

Applicant further alleges that both the R. C. Storrie and Company and the Feather River Power Company have informed applicant that they had no objection to the abandonment of said agency.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified by letter that it has no objection to the closing of said agency.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter

in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to The Western Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, to abandon its agency at the station of Storrie, located on the Main Line of its Western Division in Plumas County, provided this station is continued in the company's records as a non-agency station and the tariffs are amended in accordance with the rules of this Commission.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
