FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, A. H. Elliot, to whom the Railroad Commission by its Decision No. 13649, dated June 3, 1924, and issued on Application No. 10117, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive service for the transportation of passengers, freight, express and baggage between Hollister and Cionega and intermediate points, has requested authority to discontinue said operation, basing said request on the declaration that his passenger revenue for one year totaled \$4.25 and that he transported no freight nor express,

Now, therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said A. H. Elliot be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue said service and the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to him by said Decision No. 13649 is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules filed by said A.H. Elliot with the Railroad Commission covering said service be and the same are hereby canceled.
