FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, applicant herein, on November 19, 1928, requested the Commission for an extension of time of ninety (90) days from the limit of time mentioned in Condition (6) of the Commission's Decision No. 20139, dated August 21, 1928, in the above entitled proceeding.

Condition (6) of the above mentioned Decision required applicant to file with this Commission, within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order, a certified copy of a franchize or permit from the City of San Diego for the construction of the crossing authorized therein.

It appears to this Commission that this request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit of the compliance with Condition (6) of the Commission's Decision No. 20139, of August 21, 1928, as specified in said Order in the

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above entitled matter, be and it is hereby extended to March 1, 1929.

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 20139, of August 21, 1928, in this matter shall remain in full force and effect.
