SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION and ORDER

W. H. Pimentel, in a supplemental application, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing him to change the route of the automotive stage service he is now operating between Sacramento and North Sacramento so that on alternate trips entry into Sacramento may be made over and along 12th Street and 16th Street, thus performing a loop operation and giving service to a greater number of persons.

The Sacramento Northern Railroad and Beverly Gibson, interested carriers, have advised the Commission, the first named by letter, and the latter verbally, that they will not oppose the granting of this application.

In view of all the circumstances we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the supplemental application herein for an order authorizing W. H. Pimentel to re-route the service he is now performing between Sacramento and North. Sacramento so as to permit of a loop service via 12th Street and 16th Street as described in the supplemental application herein be and the same is hereby granted.
