ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, filed the above numbered application with this Commission on the 31st day of October, 1928, asking for authority to execute an agreement entered into on the 9th day of June, 1928, relating to the joint use of trackage and facilities of said applicant and the Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company in the City of Fullerton, County of Orange, California, as shown on the map attached to the agreement (No. L-20-9130), a copy of which is filed with the application, made a part thereof and marked Exhibit "A". On the 27th day of November, 1928, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation, filed an amendment to the above application, wherein said Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company joined in said application. It appears to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that the proposed agreement is just and reasonable, and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and the Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company be, and they are hereby granted authority to carry into effect the agreement herein before mentioned.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
