## BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of two industrial tracks at Clovis, in the County of Fresno, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with this Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of two industrial spur tracks serving the property of Shaver Lake Lumber Company and located at Clovis on its Clovis Branch in Fresno County, and shown in yellow on a blue-print map (M.W.D. Drawing 6560), attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the track herein proposed to be abandoned is owned by applicant and is constructed in part on private property adjoining its right-of-way; that the track was constructed in 1904 for the Fresno Flume and Irrigation Company, which has been succeeded by the Shaver Lake Lumber Company, and that the Southern California Edison Company, owners of the Shaver Lake Lumber Company, have asked the applicant to remove the tracks from their property.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove two spur tracks serving the Shaver Lake Lumber Company, and located at Clovis on its Clovis Branch in Fresno County, and as more definitely shown in yellow on map (M.W.D. Drawing 6580) attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
