BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, party at interest in this proceeding, having by letter requested that a clearance of seven feet and six inches be maintained for a period of ninety days during the construction of overhead crossing granted in Decision No. 20211 in the above entitled matter and it appearing to this Commission that said request is reasonable, that it is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that said request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition (2) of this Commission's Decision No. 20211, dated September 15, 1928, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) Said overgrade crossing shall be constructed with clearances conforming to the provisions of this Commission's General Orders No. 26-C and No. 64, provided, however, that

until March 7, 1929, or during the period of construction, a side clearance of seven (7) feet and six (6) inches may be maintained and during the time said impaired clearance is maintained no engine, car, motor or train shall be operated through said overgrade crossing at a speed greater than twenty (20) miles per hour.

In all other respects this Commission's decision in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
