FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Charles B. Bacon, operator of an auto trucking service between Dehesa Valley and San Diego, has requested authority to discontinue operation of said service for a period of six months, basing his request on a declaration that his operations, due to activities of private carriers, for several months past, have been conducted at a loss of approximately \$200 a month, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said Charles B. Bacon be and he is hereby authorized to temporarily discontinue operation of the trucking service described herein for a period of six months from and after January 1, 1929.
