WHEREAS, said re-routing is designed to meet with the requirements of the City of Los Angeles as to down-town terminal facilities, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Guy C. Lyons be and he is hereby authorized to operate the automotive passenger stage service authorized by Railroad Commission Decision No.20414 and Decision No.20508 over and along the following route:

From Sixth and Front Streets southerly to Seventh Street, westerly to Center Street, southerly on Center Street to Ninth Street, westerly on Ninth Street to Dodson Street, westerly on Western Avenue to Miraleste Plaza, returning southerly by way of Granvia Miraleste and Colinita Streets to Western Avenue, easterly on Western Avenue to Dodson Street, easterly on Ninth Street to Center Street, thence northerly on Center Street to Seventh Street, thence easterly on Seventh Street to Palos Verdes Street,

thence northerly on Palos Verdes Street to Fifth Street, thence easterly on Fifth Street to Front Street, thence southerly on Front Street to the downtown terminal at Sixth and Front Streets.
