FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, George W. Hicks and James Vassallo, applicants herein, never established the service herein authorized, as may be noted by reference to Decision No.19691, dated May 2, 1928, and issued on Application No.6115, from which we quote as follows:

\*\*\*\*\*No service was ever rendered by Hicks and Vassallo and, although \*\*\*\* the road was open for travel, no operation was ever commenced under the authority conferred by Decision No.6329, nor have any tariffs or time schedules been filed in accordance with the Commission's requirements and regulations \*\*\*\*\*."

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to George W. Hicks and James Vassallo by Decision No.6329 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled.
