FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Guy Ames, operator of the Bakersfield-Glennville Stage Line has, in writing, under date of December 26, 1928, requested authority to discontinue the automotive passenger stage service he was authorized to perform by Railroad Commission Decision No. 14025, declaring that the operation is unremunerative, his receipts for the year ending December 26, 1928, totaling \$135, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Guy Ames by Railroad Commission Decision No. 14025 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules filed by said Guy Ames covering service authorized by said decision be and the same are hereby canceled.
