ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filled with this Commission an application for an order authorizing the discontinuance of the maintenance of a caretaker at the station of Tarm Springs, County of Alameda, California.

Applicant alleges that the business transacted at said station of Warm Springs no longer requires the maintenance of a caretaker, and that the station work incidental to handling less-than-carload business from or to said Warm Springs Station is taken care of by the agents at Milpitas or Irvington, the nearest agency stations on either side of said Warm Springs Station.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has signified by letter that it has no objection to the removal of said caretaker.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY OFFICED that permission and authority be, and it is, hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corpora-

tion, to abandon the maintenance of a caretaker at the station of Warm Springs on its Western Division, in the County of Alameda, State of California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
