## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 10, 1928, this Commission issued an Order to E. C. Granucci directing him to appear and show cause why he should not be punished for contempt for failure to respond to a subpoent calling for his appearance at the hearing in the above entitled matter held on November 5, 1928.

Prior to the hearing on this Order to Show Cause respondent filed an affidavit setting forth that on November 5, 1928, he was suffering from influenza, likewise, that his father had died on the same date. Attached to the affidavit is a certificate of the San Francisco Board of Health confirming the fact of the death on November 5, 1928, of Gisberto Granneci, respondent's father. In view of these circumstances, we do not feel that we should proceed any further with this matter, and it will, therefore, be dismissed.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY OFDERED that the contempt

proceeding directed against E. C. Granneci be, and the same is hereby dismissed.
