ORDER

The Key System Transit Company, a corporation, having made application to this Commission for permission to abandon its franchise rights, service, tracks and other equipment, on a portion of its so-called Santa Clara Avenue line in the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California, described as follows:

Second Street from Broadway to Franklin Street, thence along Franklin Street to Water Street, also Water Street from Broadway to Webster Street, thence along Webster Street to the north end of the north approach of the Webster Street Bridge.

and,

It appearing that the abandonment of the remainder

of this line having been authorized by the Commission in its Decision No. 20231, dated September 18, 1928, in Application No. 14934, that the Webster Street Bridge connecting the cities of Alameda and Oakland, across which this line operated, has been removed, and that no service is now being operated by applicant over the above described route, and

It appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that it is in the public interest that the above entitled application be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is, hereby granted to Key System Transit Company to abandon its franchise rights, service, track and other equipment on the following described streets in the city of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California, to wit:

Second Street from Broadway to Franklin Street, thence along Franklin Street to Water Street, also Water Street from Broadway to Webster Street, thence along Webster Street to the north end of the north approach of the Webster Street Bridge.

This authority is granted subject to the condition that applicant shall, within six (6) months from the date of this order remove all rails, ties, overhead wires, poles and all its equipment from the streets above described in the City of Oakland and shall place the portion of said streets

now occupied by its equipment in the same condition as the remainder of the streets.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
