FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, D. G. Henderson, to whom the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 20574 granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive service for the transportation of passengers between the corner of Washington and Rimpau Boulevards in the City of Los Angeles and Roosevelt and 83rd Street in the County of Los Angeles, has failed to comply with the order of the Commission requiring that he file an acceptance of said certificate within a period not to exceed ten (10) days from the date of said order (December 13, 1928), and has also failed to comply with that part of said order requesting that he file tariffs and time schedules within a period of not to exceed twenty (20) days from the date thereof, and

WHEREAS, mail addressed to said D. G. Henderson at his last known address has been returned to the Commission, marked by postal authorities "unclaimed" and

WHEREAS, the present whereabouts of said D. G. Henderson is not known to his attorney, now

Therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to D. G. Henderson by Decision No.20574 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled because of failure to comply with the provisions of the order contained in said Decision No.20574.
