OBINION

This is an application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, for an order approving a certain agreement, dated September 27, 1928, made and entered into by and between applicant and Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, engaged in the operation of an electric railroad in Marin County, California. A copy of this agreement, marked "Exhibit A," is attached to the application.

The agreement provides that applicant will furnish electric energy, under its filed Schedule P-9, to Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company. Applicant's estimated cost of providing facilities to render such service is Seventy Thousand (70,000) Dollars. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company agrees to receive such service for a period of five (5) years and to install for operation electric apparatus of certain minimum rated kilowatt capacities. The Commission is of the opinion that the agreement is

fair to both parties and that a public hearing in this proceeding is not necessary.

ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having applied to this Commission for an order approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, dated September 27, 1928, the Commission having considered the matter and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above mentioned agreement between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company be and the same is hereby approved.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
