Decision No. 20706.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of the COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE for the installation of a grade crossing over the main tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company at a point in the vicinity of Edom.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition (2) of Decision No. 20510, dated November 21, 1928, be and it is hereby amended to read:

(2) The crossing shall be constructed of a width not less than twenty (20) feet and at an angle of fifty-four (54) degrees to the railroad and with grades of approach not greater than four (4) per cent; shall be constructed substantially in accordance with Standard No. 2 as specified in General Order No. 72 of this Commission; shall be protected by a Standard No. 1 crossing sign as specified in General Order No. 75 of this Commission, and shall in every way be made suitable for the passage thereon of vehicular and other road traffic.

In all other respects this Commission's order here-

before entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain  
in full force and effect.
