FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Palos Verdes Transportation Company, a corporation, engaged in the business of transporting passengers by motor bus between Redondo Beach and Palos Verdes Estates, has, in a supplemental application herein, requested authority to re-route its line within the limits of Palos Verdes Estates, and

WHEREAS, said re-routing is designed, so applicant declares, to give service to a territory in which a number of new homes have recently been built, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Palos Verdes Transportation Company be and it is hereby authorized to operate the automotive transportation service heretofore authorized by this Commission, over and along the following route instead of the route authorized by Decision No. 20412:

Redondo Beach Terminus; Pacific Avenue and Emerald Street (with stop at General Bus Station, 116 N. Pacific Avenue to pick up passengers); Pacific Avenue; Esplanade; Redondo & Wilmington Blvd.; Huntington Road to entrance Palos Verdes Estates, Cranvia La Costa, Via Anita; Via Alameda; Granvia Valmonte; Via Nivel, Via Picaposte, Via Alcance, Via Largavista, Via Picaposte, Via Solano, Via Nivel, Via Alcance, Hawthorne Avenue, Granvia Valmonte; Via Compesina; Via Corta; Malaga Cove Plaza; Cranvia La Costa to intersection with Via Coronel, Palos Verdes Estate Terminus; Returning Granvia La Costa, Via Montemar, Via Del Monte, La Venta, Via Conejo, Via Del Monte, Via Corta, Malaga Cove Plaza, Granvia La Costa, Huntington Road, Redondo & Wilmington Blvds., Esplanade; Pacific Avenue to intersection with Emerald Street (proceeding to 116 N. Pacific Avenue to pick up passengers.)

On trips to school; Malaga Cove Plaza; via Corta;
via Almar to intersection with via Arroya; and
return via same route to Malaga Cove Plaza.
