

Decision No. 20736.**ORIGINAL**

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of HOME TELEPHONE COMPANY OF COVINA, a corporation, for an order authorizing it to purchase THE FOLLOWS TOLL LINE, and authorizing the Follows Toll Line to retire from the telephone business, authorizing the Home Telephone Company of Covina to enter and render telephone service in the territory involved, and establish rates therefor.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission, in its Decision No. 19107, ordered that Home Telephone Company of Covina should complete and make ready for service, two new toll lines from Covina into San Gabriel Canyon, and should charge and collect rates as set forth in Exhibit "A", a part of that order, after a showing to this Commission that the necessary construction had been completed, and upon the issuance of a supplemental order by this Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission has evidence to the effect that Home Telephone Company of Covina has completed two new toll circuits from Covina to the site of the San Gabriel River Dam, in San Gabriel Canyon, as referred to in the above mentioned decision,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Home Telephone Company of

Covina be, and it is hereby authorized to publish, file and make effective as of March 1, 1929, schedules of rates for toll telephone service as set forth in Exhibit "A" of this Commission's Decision No. 19107, provided such schedules be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before Feb. 15, 1929.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
