BY THE COMMISSION:

TENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, in Decision No. 9840 in the above entitled matter this Commission provided with reference to Schedules 1, 2 and 5 of Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease upon approval of the Railroad Commission on the basis of Three (3) Cents per thousand cubic feet for each Ten (10) cents increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below the price of \$1.65 per barrel f.o.b. Santa Cruz and \$1.73 per barrel f.o.b. Watsonville, and

Whereas, in Decision No. 9725 this Commission provided with reference to Schedules Nos. 1 and 3 therein established for Contra Costa Gas Company that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease upon approval of the Railroad Commission on the basis of Three (3) Cents per thousand cubic feet for each Ten (10) Cents increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below the price of \$1.64 per barrel f.o.b. Pittsburg, and

Whereas, the property of Contra Costa Gas Company has been purchased by Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company and Schedules Nos. 1 and 3 of Contra Costa Gas Company, as referred to in our Decision No. 9725, are now designated as Schedules Nos. 7 and 9 of Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company, and

Whereas, Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company now makes affidavit that on January 15, 1929 the price of oil was reduced to \$1.04 per barrel f.o.b. Santa Cruz, \$1.12 per barrel f.o.b. Watsonville and \$.89 per barrel f.o.b. Pittsburg, being Sixty-one (61) Cents less than the basic prices established for Santa Cruz and Watsonville upon which rates were established in Decision No. 9840, and Seventy-five (75) Cents less than the basic price upon which rates were established for Pittsburg in Decision No. 9725,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company, effective for all regular readings taken on and after February 14, 1929, reduce its present rates designated as Schedules Nos. 1, 2 and 5 so that said rates shall be Eighteen (18) Cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rates established in Decision No. 9840 for Santa Cruz and Watsonville and reduce its present rates designated as Schedules Nos. 7 and 9, so that said rates shall be Twenty-two (22) Cents less than the basic rates established in Decision No. 9725,

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company file with this Commission a revision of its schedules to comply with this order on or before February 14, 1929.
