BY THE COMMISSION:

FIFTE SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 11096 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided with reference to Schedule No. 1 therein established that said rate would upon order of the Railroad Commission be subject to decrease on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents decrease in the cost of oil below the price of \$1.50 per barrel f.o.b. Hanford, and

WHEREAS, Southern California Gas Company has purchased the properties of Hanford Gas and Power Company and said Schedule No. 1 has been superseded by Schedule E-3 of Southern California Gas Company, and

WHEREAS, Southern California Gas Company now makes affidavit that on and after January 18, 1929, the price of oil was reduced to \$.868 per barrel f.o.b. Hanford, making the present price of oil sixty-three (63) cents per barrel below the base price established in Decision No. 11096.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company reduce its Schedule E-3 effective for all meter readings taken on and after February 18, 1929, so that said rate shall be equal to

nineteen (19) cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rates established in Decision No. 11096.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company file with this Commission on or before February 18, 1929, a revision of its rates as herein ordered.
