THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, this Commission in its Decision No. 15556, dated October 21, 1925, and Decision No. 15848, dated January 14, 1926, in the above matter, modified its Decision No. 11095, dated October 9, 1922, in Case No. 1806, so as to provide with reference to Schedules "A" and "B" of Riverbend Gas and Water Company that said rates with the exception of the first 400 cubic feet in Schedule "A" shall be subject to increase or decrease upon approval of the Railroad Commission on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents increase or decrease in the price of oil above or below the price of \$1.65 per barrel f.o.b. Dinuba, provided further that no increase in such rates shall be made after the cost of oil to applicant exceeds \$2.15 per barrel f.o.b. Dinuba, and

WHEREAS, Southern California Gas Company has purchased the properties of Riverbend Gas and Water Company and said Schedules "A" and "B" are superseded by Schedules E-4 and E-5 of Southern California Gas Company, and

WHEREAS, Southern California Gas Company now makes

affidavit that on and after January 18, 1929, the price of oil was reduced to \$1.031 per barrel f.o.b. Dinuba, making the present price of oil sixty-two (62) cents per barrel below the basic price established in Decision No. 11095.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company reduce its rates designated as Schedules E-4 and E-5, effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after February 18, 1929, so that said rates with the exception of the first 400 cubic feet in Schedule E-4 shall be nineteen (19) cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rates established in Decision No. 11095.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company file with this Commission on or before February 18, 1929, a revision of its schedules to comply with this order.
