BY THE COMMISSION:

EIGHTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Whereas, in Decision No. 9839, (20 C.R.C. 948) this Commission provided, with reference to Schedules "A" and "B" of Modesto Gas Company, that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of 2.6 cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below \$2.00 per barrel F.O.B. Modesto; and

Whereas, Modesto Gas Company now makes affidavit that effective January 16, 1929, the price paid for fuel oil F.O.B. Modesto has been further reduced to \$1.12 per barrel which is eighty-eight (88) cents per barrel below the base price upon which rates were established in Decision No. 9839,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Modesto Gas Company reduce its rates designated as Schedules "A" and "B," effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after February 15, 1929, so that said rates shall be twenty-three (23) cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rate established in Decision No. 9839.

IS IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Modesto Gas Company

file with this Commission on or before February 15, 1929, a revision of its schedules to comply with this order.
