BY THE COMMISSION:

TENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 9,125 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided, with reference to the rates therein established, that such rates would be subject to increase or decrease by amounts as set forth therein upon approval of the Railroad Commission based upon a change in the price paid for oil in the various communities served, and

WHEREAS, Schedules Nos. C-10, G-12 and G-13 are subject to increase or decrease based upon change in the price paid for oil, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now make affidavit that a further reduction in the price of oil was made effective January 15, 1929, and an additional reduction in the price of fuel oil was made effective January 18, 1929,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for gas service as determined in Decision No. 15,626, effective for all meter readings taken on and after February 14, 1929, so that the rates of the several

schedules shall be less than the basic rates of the respective schedules set forth in Decision No. 9,125 by the following amounts:

Schedule C-1,	17¢	per 1,000 cu. ft.
Schedule C-3,	27¢	" " " "
Schedule C-4,	19¢	" " " "
Schedule C-5,	21¢	" " " "
Schedule C-6,	21¢	" " " "
Schedule C-7,	26¢	" " " "
Schedule C-8,	29¢	" " " "
Schedule C-9,	22¢	" " " "

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for gas service rendered under Schedule No. C-10, effective for meter readings taken on and after February 14, 1929, so that the rates therein shall be Seven (7) Cents per 1,000 cubic feet less than the rates established in Decision No. 16,020.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company decrease the rates for gas service rendered under Schedules Nos. C-12 and C-13, effective for meter readings taken on and after February 14, 1929, so that the rates therein shall be Four (4) Cents and Five (5) Cents per 1,000 cubic feet, respectively, less than the rates now applying under Schedules Nos. C-12 and C-13.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company file with the Commission on or before February 14, 1929, revisions of its schedules as herein authorized.
