FIFTE SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 12,582 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided, that upon its approval the steam rates of Great Western Power Company be subject to increase or decrease of three (3) cents per thousand pounds of steam for each ten (10) cents per barrel increase or decrease, respectively, in the cost of oil above or below the price in effect August 1, 1923, which price was \$1.10 per barrel, and

WHEREAS, Great Western Power Company now makes affidavit that on January 15, 1929, the price paid for oil was reduced by fifteen (15) cents per barrel, as the result of which the price paid by that company for oil will, until further change be \$1.09 per barrel, which is one (1) cent less than the basic price upon which rates were established in Decision No. 12,582.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Great Western Power Company

reduce its present rates for steam, designated as Schedule No. S-1, for all regular meter readings taken on and after February 14, 1929, so that said rates shall be equal to the basic rate established in Decision No. 12,582.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Great Western Power Company file with the Commission on or before February 14, 1929, a revision of its rates as herein ordered.
