SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Decision No. 12580 (23 C.R.C. 841) in the above entitled matter provides, with reference to the steam rates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, that such rates be subject to increase or decrease upon approval of this Commission on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand pounds of steam for each ten (10) cent increase or decrease, respectively, per barrel in the price of oil above or below the price in effect on August 1, 1923, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company now makes
affidavit that on January 15, 1929, the price paid for oil was
reduced to eighty-seven (87) cents per barrel, and that on
January 18, 1929, this price was further reduced to eightythree (83) cents per barrel, which latter price is ten (10) cents
per barrel less than the basic price upon which rates were

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established in Decision No. 12580.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Pacific Cas and Electric Company reduce its present rates for steam, designated as Schedule No. S-1, for all regular meter readings taken on and after February 14, 1929, so that said rates shall be equal to three (3) cents less than the basic rates established in Decision No. 12580.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Pacific Gas and Electric Company file with the Commission on or before February 14, 1929, a revision of its rates as herein ordered.
