BY THE COMMISSION -

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, reports filed with the Railroad Commission by Motor Transit Company covering operation by it of an automotive sightseeing service out of Los Angeles through Orange County, which service was authorized by the Commission in its Decisions Nos.18716 and 19817, show that but 14 passengers were transported in a period of six months, and

WHEREAS, such limited patronage does not justify continued operation of the service, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Motor Transit Company be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue operation of said sightseeing service, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Motor Transit Company by Decision No.18716, as modified by/No.19817, be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Motor Transit Company shall immediately file supplements to its tariffs and time schedules covering said service which supplements shall cancel said tariffs and time schedules.
