BIFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of OAKDALE GAS COMPANY, a corporation, for an Order Authorizing an Increase in Rates for Gas Service.

Application No. 10800.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 14883, dated May 7, 1925, established rates to be charged by the Oakdale Gas Company and provided that such rates would upon order of the Railroad Commission be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents increase or decrease, respectively, in the price of oil above or below \$1.90 per barrel in Oakdalo, and further provided that no increase shall be made after the price of oil f.o.b. Oakdale passes \$2.40 per barrel; and

WHEREAS, the cost of oil was recently further reduced to \$1.18% per barrel f.o.b. Cakdale, being a decrease of 15% cents per barrel, and under the conditions established in Decision No. 14883 requiring a reduction of 5 cents per M.C.F. effective February 14, 1929, and

WHEREAS, Cakdale Cas Company has filed, effective February 14, 1929, the basic rate hereto attached as Exhibit "",

said rate being subject to increase or decrease of three (3) cents per M.C.F. for each ten (10) cent increase or decrease, respectively, in the cost of oil above or below \$1.1825 per barrel f.o.b. Oakdale, and said basic rate being lower than the basic rate established in Decision No. 14883,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the basic rate set forth in Exhibit "A", hereto attached and made a part hereof, be substituted in lieu of the rates established in Decision No. 14883, provided that no increase shall be made after the price of oil f.o.b. Oakdale passes \$2.40 per barrel.
