In the matter of the application of the COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES for order authorizing a grade crossing over the Southern Pacific Railroad Company's right of way on Pomona Boulevard.

Application No. 15,191.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company having requested permission to maintain said crossing No. B-500.5 without Standard No. 1 crossing sign, and said request appearing reasonable,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No. 2 in Decision No.20,677 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) The crossing shall be maintained of a width not less than forty (40) feet and at an angle of ninety (90) degrees to the railroad and with grades of approach not greater than three (3) per cent; shall be constructed substantially in accordance with Standard No. 3, as specified in General Order No. 72 of this Commission; shall be protected by two Standard No. 3 wigwags, as specified in General Order No. 75 of this Commission, such protection to be maintained by Southern Pacific Company, and shall in every way be maintained suitable for the passage thereon of vehicles and other road traffic.

In all other respects this Commission's order heretofore entered in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect.
