1. The authority granted herein shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been

made on or before June 30, 1929.

- 2. A certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said Public Utilities California Corporation within thirty (30) days from the date of its execution.
- 3. The consideration for the sale of the property herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than authorized herein.

The authority granted herein shall become effective upon the date hereof.
