Southern Pacific Company, one of the parties herein having requested a modification of the Commission's order heretofore entered in this proceeding, and applicant having on April 3, 1929, consented to said modification,

IT IS HERREY ORDERED that the Commission's Decision No. 20234, dated September 20, 1928, in the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby modified to provide for the construction of the crossing therein authorized at a point approximately four-hundred feet (400°) east of Soda Springs Station instead of at a point approximately three-hundred feet (300°) east of said station as specified in said order.

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 20234 shall remain in full force and effect.
