SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon further consideration of the record in the above entitled proceeding, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the third paragraph of our order entered in the above entitled proceeding on March 4, 1929, be and the same is hereby amended and modified to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that defendant, Southern Pacific Company, be and it is hereby notified and required to establish on or before thirty (30) days from the effective date of this order on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public, and thereafter to apply to the transportation of slack barrels, in carloads, from San Francisco to El Centro a rate of 91 cents, and from Los Angeles to El Centro a rate not to exceed the rate contemporaneously in effect from Los Angeles to equidistant points in the San Joaquin Valley."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects our order dated March 4, 1929, in the above entitled proceeding be and the same shall remain in full force and effect.
