Long, et al., has requested a supplemental order of the Railroad Commission authorizing him to serve intermediate points between Susanville and Bieber, service to said intermediate points having been given by his predecessors and by him under the impression that authority to give such service was contained in the certificate of public convenience and necessity he acquired from W.IL Long, et al., and

ORDER ON SUPPLEMENTAL

WHEREAS, the Longs filed tariffs showing service to intermediate points, said tariffx being adopted by Mitchell by order of the Commission in the transfer proceedings, and

WHEREAS, it now appears from the records of the Commission that the order of the Commission granting operating authority to the Longs should read "between Susanville and Bieber and intermediate points", Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that David S. Mitchell be and he is hereby authorized to serve all intermediate points between Susanville and Bieber over and along the route traversed by him under authority of the certificate of public convenience and necessity he acquired from W.I. Long, et al., by Decision No.10739, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that David S. Mitchell be and he is hereby authorized to file with the Railroad Commission, tariffs and time schedules which tariffs and time schedules shall be identical with those attached to the supplemental application herein or tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
