OPINION AND ORDER ON PETITION
FOR REHEARING

City of South Pasadena has petitioned for a rehearing of our Decision No. 20,911 in the above entitled proceeding, which decision granted permission to construct the north roadway of Huntington Drive at grade across the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company. Petitioner complains of condition four (4) of said decision, which refers to the existing Spruce Street crossing.

It should be noted that the authorization to construct the Huntington Drive crossing is permissive only, and that it is optional with the City to retain the existing Spruce Street crossing or to construct the new Huntington Drive crossing.

The Commission having carefully considered said petition for rehearing, and each and every allegation contained therein, and being of the opinion that no good cause for the granting

of a rehearing is therein made to appear,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the said petition for re-hearing be and the same is hereby denied.
