FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 20967 herein, approved the transfer by Pacific Electric Railway Company to R.F. Rountree of an operating right for an automotive service in the City of Santa Ana, and

WHEREAS, said Pacific Electric Railway Company, in writing under date of May 3, 1929, has advised that said R.F. Rountree has been unable to acquire the necessary equipment to enable him to carry on the service heretofore performed by Pacific Electric Railway Company under authority of the certificate of public convenience and necessity, the transfer of which was approved, and

WHEREAS, said Pacific Electric Railway Company has requested that said Decision No. 20967 be set aside and canceled, now

Therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 20967 be and the same is set aside and annulled.
